CONSTITUTION OF THE TULANE CITY, CULTURE AND COMMUNITY STUDENT ASSOCIATION

Article I. Purpose.

This organization will provide a structure for City, Culture, & Community Graduate students to seek fellowship, education, and recreation pertaining to a shared interest in the aforementioned topic areas.

Article II. Organization.

- Section 1: The name of this organization shall be the City, Culture and Community Graduate Organization (CCCGO).
- Section 2: All registered graduate students in this department are eligible to be voting members of this organization.
- Section 3: The position of faculty liaison shall be filled by a member of the CCC faculty, chosen by a majority vote of the members and the approval of the Director of Graduate Studies.
- Section 4: The officers of this organization shall be as follows:
 - A. President, Secretary-Treasurer and 2 Representatives who will attend meetings of the Graduate Studies Student Association (GSSA), our umbrella association.
 - B. The President and Secretary-Treasurer will be elected by the general membership during the spring semester, to serve for the following academic year. Representatives shall be elected n the fall to serve for the current academic year.
- Section 5: Membership shall be assessed by majority vote.
- Section 6: A minimum of two meetings shall be held during each semester of the academic year. Other meetings may be called as necessary.

Article III. Amendments.

This constitution may be amended by a majority vote of the members.
