Travel Funding 45%

Entertainment \$46,500— this is \$6,000 less than last year.

A lot of the budget goes to entertainment. This includes departmental and GSSA-wide events from the same pot of money as the departmental events. Overview coming for prospective GSSA, and reps have power to approve or disapprove.
