If you're registered to vote in Louisiana, I wanted to encourage you to go out and vote in the election on Saturday, March 29th - essentially this election is to approve/deny new amendments to LA's state constitution. Amendment #2 would dissolve the LA board of Governors Research Trust - this board is funding at least one of Tulane's fMRI research grants, so dissolving the board would mean this grant money would be lost. Overall, the proposed amendment results in defunded research money in addition to removing non-profit taxable status from schools and hospitals. As much as I would strongly encourage you to DENY the second amendment, I also wanted to point you in the direction of this non-partisan voting guide by PAR Louisiana https://parlouisiana.org/publications/guide-to-the-constitutional-amendments/
